Things to look for

1.	Internal inconsistencies
2.	Inconsistencies with other, especially objective evidence
3.	Poor opportunity to observe - light, duration, distance, angle
4.	Contamination and information from different sources
5.	Reference to or reliance on things post-dating incident
6.	Capacity to recall given personal characteristics, time since incident, whether
	contemporaneous records available
7.	Assumptions
8.	Reconstruction
